Out of this fellowship grew the Church on the Hill which she founded in the fall of 1995. Services are held two Sundays a month at the Days Inn in Capitol Heights, Md.

Rev. Koroma is also president of the National Network of Christian Men and Women, which provides professional and spiritual support for men and women in business, ministry, and the professional marketplace. The organization meets on Capitol Hill.

Rev. Koroma worked in several local churches as a student minister and served as a missionary in Europe and South America




