LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ The cornerstone of an estate plan.▶ The most-utilized tool of charitable giving.▶ May include bequests to your church and/or preferred ministries.▶ Revocable.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Ensures your wishes are carried out after death.▶ Is exempt from federal estate taxes.▶ Eases the process for loved ones when you die. <p><i>Note: If you have no will when you die, the Commonwealth of Virginia will settle your estate and control your disbursements.</i></p>
DONOR-ADVISED FUND	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ A tool that provides consistent giving to your church and/or preferred ministries.▶ A way to memorialize a loved one through an ongoing instrument that gives to charity annually and, depending on the distribution levels, in perpetuity.▶ Irrevocable. \$5,000 minimum.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Allows immediate tax deduction, subject to IRS.▶ Avoids capital gains taxes, subject to IRS.▶ Flows through your fund without need for a private foundation.▶ Verifies nonprofits for legitimacy prior to distribution.▶ Continues tithing to your church, even after death.
CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUST	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ A tool that transfers appreciated assets (stocks, real estate, cash) from your estate to an irrevocable trust that provides income.▶ At your death, the remaining trust assets, or the annual income, will go to your church and/or preferred ministries.▶ Irrevocable.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Converts appreciated assets into income-producing assets.▶ Provides income for the remainder of your life through a unitrust or annuity trust.▶ Provides a charitable income tax deduction now.▶ Bypasses capital gains taxes.
